Do's & Don'ts

The front gate is the main point of access for vehicular traffic and can be very busy & congested at times. Our guards/attendants often have their hands full admitting cars, trucks, friends and vendors. For them to do their jobs effectively, we need the support from all of our homeowners. Here are some items to consider relative to the gate:

| Give a friendly waive as you pass through to the guard | Stop in the entrance or block traffic |
| Call via telephone if a verbal conversation is necessary | Walk up to the gate and converse |
| Use Gate Sentry for admitting guests and vendors | Approach the gate with a request for your guests or vendors |
| Move through the gate area as quickly as safety allows | Linger or loiter moving through the gate area |
| Use the sidewalk and pedestrian gates for egress/access | Walk through the vehicular street access areas |
